

PUBLIC NOTICE

Calhoun County is requesting public comment in regard to the submission of an application to the Texas General Land Office (GLO) for Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds associated with Hurricane Harvey recovery. The application is for proposed non-housing infrastructure projects to utilize \$5,936,548.00 in funding allocated by the Golden Crescent Regional Planning Commission for long-term disaster recovery efforts.

The County's proposed projects will document direct storm damage and expend funds that principally benefit low-to-moderate income areas of the county.

As a part of the requirements to receive the disaster recovery funds, the County must provide for public review and comment of the proposed projects for 30-days from July 26th – August 26th, 2019. The County is giving residents an opportunity to voice opinions on the proposed projects by viewing the draft application on the County's website <http://www.calhouncotx.org>
