Calhoun County has partnered with the Texas General Land Office (GLO) and Texas Parks & Wildlife (TP&W) to offer county residents the opportunity to dispose of inoperable and derelict vessels through the "Vessel Turn-In Program" (VTIP)

Location 1 - 900 Landfill Road Port Lavaca, TX Commissioner David Hall - Pct 1 Commissioner Vern Lyssy - Pct 2

Location 2 - 448 Harbor Rd, Seadrift, TX Commissioner Gary Reese - Pct 4

VTIP is designed to provide owners with a voluntary free method for the disposal of unwanted vessels.

- The vessel must be brought to one of two drop off points. The Texas GLO and TP&W will verify the vessel (boat) qualifies for disposal. All hazardous materials (fuel, oil, and batteries) will be removed, the vessel destroyed, and then transported to the landfill for disposal.
- Boat must be clear of waste and debris.
- No Trash in Boats.







• You are encouraged to participate in this **free** program if you own a vessel under 26' feet long in need of disposal.

(longer boats may be accepted on a case by case basis).
