A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF CALHOUN COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO SUBMIT A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT **BLOCK GRANT** DISASTER **RECOVERY OFFICE** APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS GENERAL LAND FOR LOCAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAMS AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO **COUNTY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER** AND **AUTHORIZED** RESPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND REVITALIZATION **HURRICANE HARVEY PROGRAM** 

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Calhoun County desires to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain condition exists related to Hurricane Harvey, an eligible federally declared disaster in 2017, which represents a threat to the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of Calhoun County to apply for funding under the Community Development & Revitalization Grant Program Disaster Recovery Program; and

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED;

Section 1. That a Community Development & Revitalization Hurricane Harvey application for infrastructure projects is hereby authorized to be filed with the Texas General Land Office for funding consideration under the Community Development & Revitalization Grant Program; and

Section 2. That the application be for the Hurricane Harvey Texas General Land Office allocated grant funds to Calhoun County through the Golden Crescent Regional Council of Governments Method of Distribution to carry out Infrastructure Activities; and

Section 3. That the Commissioners Court directs and designates the County Judge as the Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in connection with this application and participation in the Community Development & Revitalization Grant Program.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
