## **LANE ROAD DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS – PHASE 2 PROJECT – PRE-BID Conference – MEETING MINUTES**

**Held at Commissioner’s Office @ Precinct 4, Seadrift, Texas**

### Attendees:

See Attached Sign in Sheet

Scott Mason (SM) opened up the meeting and welcomed everyone who was in attendance. Proceeded to introduce himself (G&W) and Veronica Pauda (VP) with KSBR attending virtually.

SM explained that this is grant project and that there are very specific requirements for the grant. Proceeded to inform everyone that all questions would be would be answer at this meeting to the best of SM ability. It was also explained that any answer given at the meeting was verbal at this time and that an addendum would be issued with every question that was asked pre, during and post meeting in the addendum and that will be the final answers. SM also notified bidders that the cut-off day and time for last questions regarding the bid documents is June 20, 2025 at 5:00 pm. From that point no answers to questions will be provided. Also, it was discussed that all questions after this pre-bid conference would need to be posted to CivcastUSA to the Q&A section.

SM began discussing some of the specific grant requirements which included conformance to the Davis Bacon Wage Rate requirements. SM discussed that it will be the contractor’s responsibility to verify their payroll and compliance and submit required forms on a weekly basis.

VP then elaborated regarding payroll, wage rates and section 3 requirements of the project.

SM discussed that all forms will be required to submitted that are noted in the package even if not applicable. SM explained that the “Specification Notes” is where you put how many calendar days and to acknowledge any future addendums. SM confirmed bid due date of July 10, 2025 at 2:00:00. Explained that bids are due at this time and date to the judge’s office and that it is located on the third floor at the court house. SM explained that bids will have to be submitted in the proposal provided in the bid package and no other formats will be allowed. SM discussed the requirement for the bidder to specify the amount of calendar days on provided form and that a bid bond/cashiers check was required for County bids over \$50,000.00. SM explained each bid item and more specifically noted that the signage for the project and that bid item was specifically for the temporary sign required of the GLO. SM stated that there is not anticipated to be required construction signage, such as “Road Work Ahead” or “Road Closed” signage necessary for the project.

SM asked if there were any further questions concerning the matters that had been discussed up to that point. At that time there were no further questions as the question concerning discussion to this point.

SM then provided an overview of the improvements and briefly explained the components of the project. Questions were verbally answered at the meeting in regards to the improvements with acknowledgement from SM that the final answers would be made in writing in the addendum to come out. SM documented each question that was asked.

No Further questions were asked regarding the plans and specifications and the meeting was adjourned.

SM did advise bidders that this project will be tax-exempt and that a certificate will be provided to the awarded bidder.

**CivCastUSA Q/A:**

***1. Would you please post the pre-bid meeting attendees list? 06/17/2025 4:20 PM***

- a. The meeting minutes will be posted with the addendum scheduled to come out on July 2, 2025. The pre-bid meeting attendees list will be included within the addendum mentioned.

**PREBID CONFERENCE RFIs June 17, 2022 – 10:00 AM:**

***1. Will "E-Verify" be required on potential employees or Section 3 prospects?***

- a. E-Verify is not explicitly mentioned in the bid package; therefore, the contractor has the discretion to determine employee eligibility for hiring and the verification process, while considering the Section 3 requirements outlined in the bid package.

***2. Will prime consultant with salary employees be required to be submitted with the certified payroll and adhere to Davis-Bacon Wage Rate requirements?***

- a. DBRA applies to "laborers and mechanics": This term covers individuals performing manual or physical work, including those working in a trade. It does not generally apply to workers whose duties are primarily administrative, executive, or clerical, rather than manual.
- b. Supervisors and forepersons may be covered: Forepersons or supervisors who spend a significant amount of their workweek (more than 20% of their time) performing mechanic or laborer duties are considered laborers and mechanics for that time and must be paid the applicable prevailing wage for those hours.
- c. In summary, DBRA does not apply to employees solely based on their salary, but rather on the nature of their work. If a salaried employee performs work that falls under the "laborer or mechanic" definition, they must be paid the prevailing wage for those hours.
- d. If awarded the project, the labor standards officer will collaborate with the prime contractor and any subcontractors to ensure that payroll and wages comply with the requirements. To be cautious, ensure that salaried employees, whether performing physical/mechanical labor or providing supervision, are paid at least the minimum wage outlined in the DBWR supplied in the document. Photos are attached to this addendum.

***3. Can you drive to the fence locations?***

- a. Yes, access to the fence locations will be provided to perform the work. With recent rain, the conditions are probably not favorable, but also not impassable.

***4. Can you provide photos of all fence locations and pipeline crossing area with recent photos?***

- a. Yes. Photos are attached to this addendum. They are labeled and dated.

***5. Do you have an estimated depth that we will need to excavate through the sides of the ditch?***

- a. Yes. More detailed elevations are provided in the form of an exhibit.

6. *Do the fence crossing need to be put back up every night if not finished?*
  - a. Yes. There is livestock present within all fenced areas. Anytime the contractor is to leave the project site or not be within eyesight of the fence, then temporary measures will need to be in place to contain livestock.
7. *Can you provide more information on the pipeline itself? Is it active, abandoned, who owns it, any other information?*
  - a. Yes. Attached you will find information regarding the pipeline.
8. *Will we have to provide cofferdam(s) at the pipeline crossing for excavation?*
  - a. This will depend on the time of year, the amount of rainfall and the conditions when ready to start construction. If the timing is right, which is the original intent of the bid, then a cofferdam will not be needed. However, we do not intend to keep pushing the project back for perfect weather and conditions. So, therefore, if a cofferdam is needed then it would be directed as a change order.
9. *Would it be best to split the pipeline bid item up into 105 with flowable backfill and 600 feet normal in-situ back fill?*
  - a. We have amended the bid form accordingly. Please ensure when submitting a bid that you use the correct bid form.
10. *Can elevations at the pipeline be given?*
  - a. Please see question 5 and answer 5.
11. *6" Diameter post and only 8' long seem short and not very big for the heavy gate...Should you consider an 8" diameter and 10' long?*
  - a. Please see the updated fence crossing detail.
12. *Can we use a hydraulic post driver?*
  - a. Means and methods will be up to the contractor.
13. *Can you confirm if the project is tax exempt?*
  - a. Yes, as regulated under the tax exemption laws, certain permanent materials and items would be tax exempt. Please see Addendum No. 1 for further clarification.

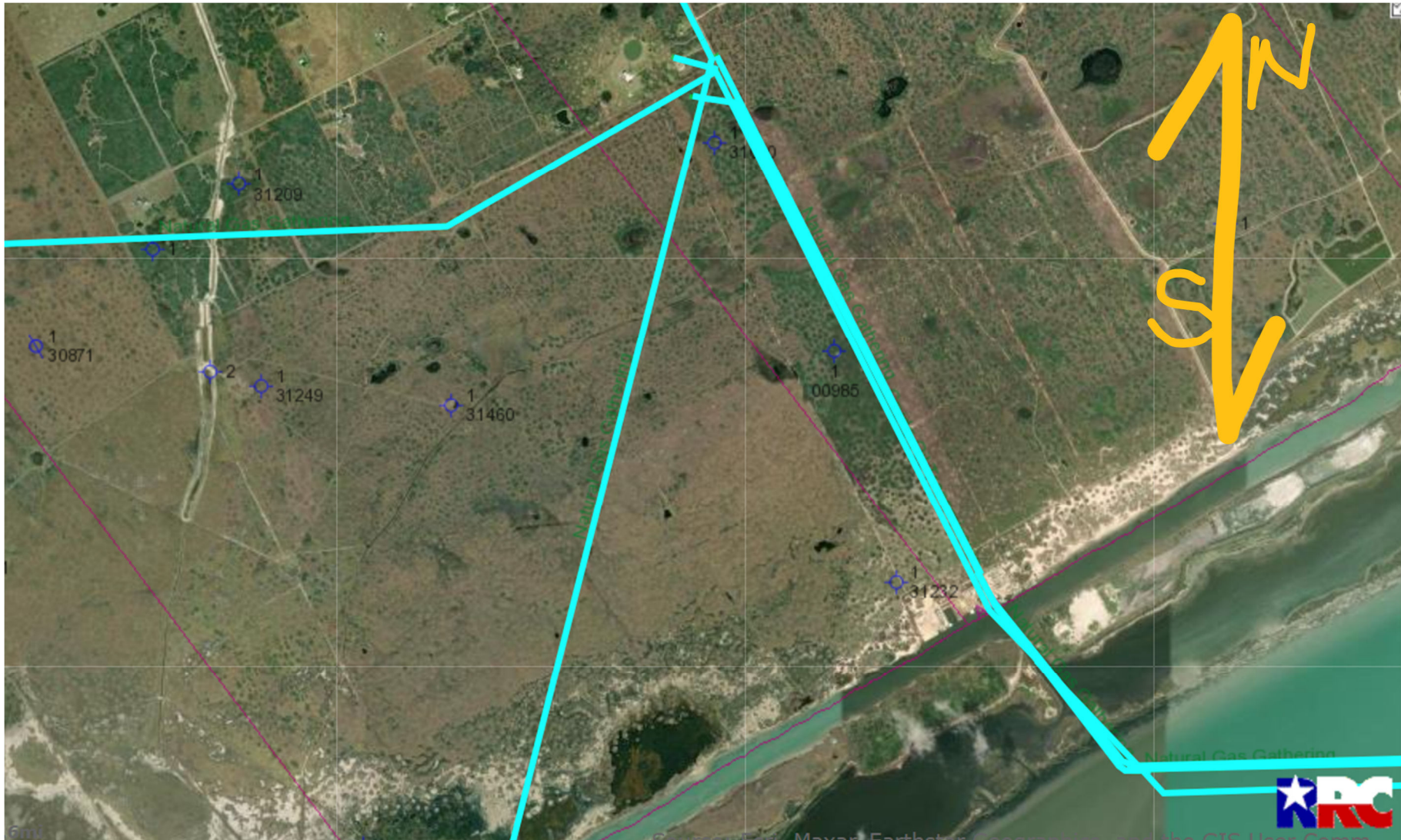

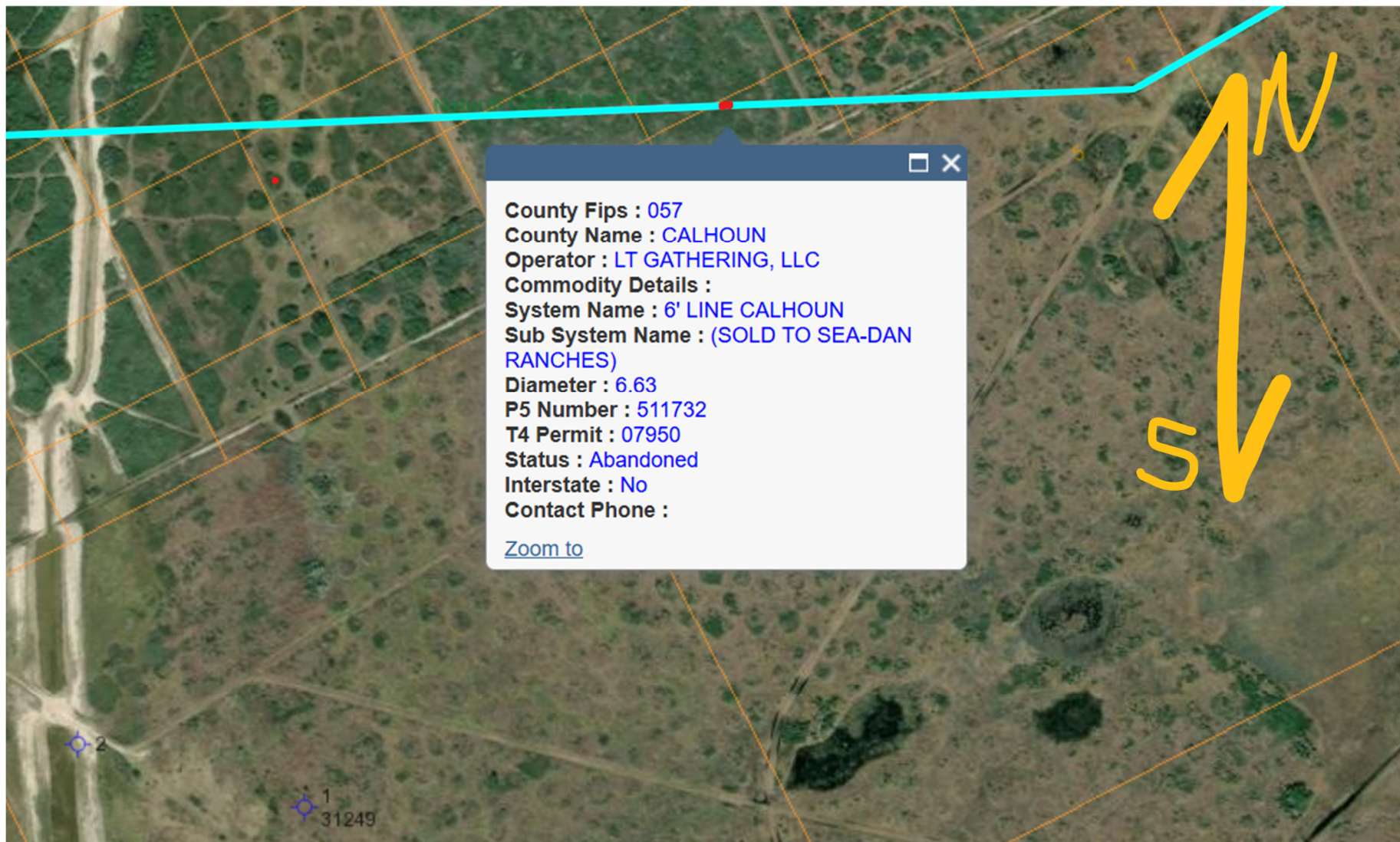

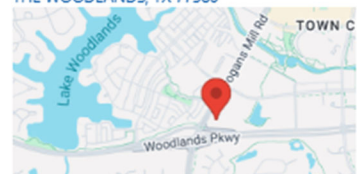
