POLICY MEMORANDUM REGARDING ADJUDICATION AND REVOCATION SETTING PROCEDURES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Court, the following procedures are adopted regarding the scheduling and disposition of **Motions to Revoke** and **Motions to Adjudicate** in the Calhoun County Court at Law No. 1:

1. Required Settings

All Motions to Revoke and Motions to Adjudicate shall be set for the following proceedings:

- **First Appearance**; Initial Setting
 - **Status Setting**;
 - **Announce Ready**; Disposition Setting and
 - **Plea Hearing**. Final Plea Setting or Ready for Trial

2. First Appearance

The defendant shall appear before the Court for First Appearance as scheduled.

3. Status Setting

The Status Setting is intended to ensure that the defendant is represented by counsel.

If an attorney has not been **appointed or retained** by the First Appearance, the Court will allow **one additional Status Setting** for the purpose of securing counsel.

4. Announce Ready

The Announce Ready setting shall serve as the **Disposition Setting**.

At this setting, the parties shall:

- Announce ready for hearing; or
 - Present any negotiated plea agreement for the Court's consideration.

5. Plea Agreements

Any resolution of the case by plea agreement must be completed on or before the Announce Ready.

6. Plea Hearing Setting

All cases not resolved at the Plea Hearing setting will proceed to a Trial Setting.

On the Plea Hearing date:

- No continuances or resets will be granted; and
 - Only plea agreements will be accepted.

7. Compliance Required

All parties are expected to comply with this Policy Memorandum. Failure to comply may result in the case proceeding to hearing as scheduled or other action as deemed appropriate by the Court.

8. Effective Date

This Policy Memorandum is effective immediately upon issuance and shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
