ORDER ADOPTING A TAX RATE FOR TAX YEAR 2018

WHEREAS, Vernon's Texas Codes Annotated (V.T.C.A.) Tax Code 26.05 provides that the Calhoun County Commissioners' Court shall adopt the tax rates for the current year; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to levy ad valorem taxes on each \$100 valuation of all taxable property in Calhoun County, Texas for the Tax Year beginning January 1, 2018, which will be due no later than January 31, 2019 at the tax rates set forth herein below; and

WHEREAS, the Calhoun County Commissioners' Court has complied with all the requirements set forth in the Tax Code; NOW

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Calhoun County Commissioners' Court hereby adopts the following tax rates:

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that if for any reason, the action of the Calhoun County Commissioners' Court setting tax rates or levying taxes should be held ineffective by a court of competent jurisdiction, that this Order shall serve as evidence of the good faith of Calhoun County in attempting to comply with the law in as substantial a fashion as could be done under the circumstances, and as evidence that Calhoun County would have lawfully adopted a tax rate but for the conditions completely beyond control of Calhoun County.
