
THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S RATE AND;

THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 3.29% AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$18.70.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Calhoun County Commissioners' Court levy taxes in accordance with the foregoing tax rates and the provision of the law.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that if for any reason, the action of the Calhoun County Commissioners' Court setting tax rates or levying taxes should be held ineffective by a court of competent jurisdiction, that this Order shall serve as evidence of the good faith of Calhoun County in attempting to comply with the law in as substantial a fashion as could be done under the circumstances, and as evidence that Calhoun County would have lawfully adopted a tax rate but for the conditions completely beyond control of Calhoun County.
